



Annual Acting Up Spotlight Scholarship Application

Acting Up was founded to provide experiences in all aspects of the theater arts to young people in our area communities. We are also pleased to provide assistance to young people to help further their education by awarding a one-time scholarship of \$500.

To be eligible for the scholarship, applicants:

- Must have been in at least one Acting Up production in either the cast or crew.
- Must currently be a senior in high school.
- Plan to continue their education at an accredited college or university in the fall following their senior year.

The scholarship will be awarded by a blind panel of three non-board member judges. All personal information will be removed before judging. This panel will select the applicant that they deem to have gone above and beyond in their contribution to Acting Up. Applications must be submitted/received no later than **March 24, 2019**.
